2. Introductions and apologies

GT gave introductions of Welsh Government staff and ran through housekeeping.

There were no issues/comments regarding last meeting's minutes, actions and comments.

3. 2021.1.n development update

GE gave an update regarding hold up of the testing due to complications accessing DEWi UAT site that has arisen due to the enforced remote working under the current circumstances. The issue will hopefully be resolved in the next week or so with testing due to start thereafter.

JH requested that any changes are made as clear as possible emphasising where something has been changed (rather than removed) and suggested an additional column. RV agreed.

4. Statutory data collections general update

School Workforce Annual Census (SWAC) 2020

GT updated the group on the 2019 and 2020 SWAC collection.

2019 data is ready to run the cross-DEWi validations between the SWAC School and SWAC HR returns. Once the validations have been run Welsh Government will provide a summary of outstanding issues to local authorities to action ready in time for the 2020 collection.

The publication date for the 2019 SWAC data has been confirmed as 30 July 2020 with more detailed analysis to be published through August.

The 2020 census date for SWAC remains as 3 November 2020. A decision is yet to be made on half term. Once decision is made we will inform the group of any impact on dates for the collection.

There is further discussion to be had on introducing a SWAC validation period, which is required in order to achieve National Statistics status for the collection.

The group questioned the impact of the use of data from different collections where there is a crossover of the data collected (such as class sizes) and their impact on deriving pupil-teacher ratios (PTR). GT confirmed that class size information will remain in the PLASC collection.

The impact on the calculation of PTRs will be added to future meetings and will require involvement from the school statistics team.

GT stated that following publication of the 2019 data and providing the summaries of issues to local authorities that the Welsh Government are keen

to have discussions with individual local authorities in preparation for the 2020 collection and to get feedback on the 2019 collection and publication.

Post-16 Census 2020

GE said there is no change from the last meeting; expecting to go ahead as normal. The justification is that by not having a collection we may lose two years' worth of performance measures data and it would likely be much more work and more complex to try and create a different and/or simplified return in a different format. Hoping to have a final decision by next SDF.

Once decision made there may be a need to review validations and technical completion notes as some may need to be turned off/amended in light of any decision made.

JH had a query regarding SWAC discount code. GE clarified that he was referring to QWAD discount code and explained there was an ongoing conversation regarding this matter.

Pupil Level Annual School Census (PLASC) and Educated Other Than At School (EOTAS) 2021

PLASC & EOTAS were covered together.

GE confirmed no major changes since last SDF and software specification versio 0.1 has been issued for PLASC and EOTAS 2021. There are some amendments we have identified regarding dates that will be released soon in a version 0.2 update.

JT raised an issue regarding class sizes and asked if the Welsh Government can look at refining and improving the automatic validations around this to minimise the checks local authorities need to make.

5.1 Next meeting

Following agreement by all attendess, the next SDF will be held on 6 August 2020. The Welsh Government will confirm agenda and timings once arrangements are made and the meeting will be held virtually using Microsoft Teams.
